The Pious Saint Parascheva of Jassy

Iasi, the capital of Moldavia, is situated in the North-Eastern part of Romania. Inside its cathedral, in a silver coffin, lie the relics of Saint Parascheva. She is considered the Patron Saint and Protector of Moldavia and each year, on October the 14th, on the Saint's Day, hundreds of thousands of people from all over the country and abroad come to Iasi to entreat the saint to intercede for them. Her holy relics were brought to Iasi in 1641 by Prince Vasile Lupu. In the Eastern Orthodox tradition there are three different saints known as St. Parascheva. The first one was born in Rome, in the 2nd century. The second one was born in Iconia and she died in the 3rd century. The third one, the one whose relics are sheltered in the metropolitan cathedral in Iasi, Romania, lived around the year 1000 A.D. and is the best known and the most widely revered by Eastern Orthodox Christians. Variations of her name include: St. Parascheva of Tirnovo, St. Parascheva the Serbian, St. Parascheva of Belgrade, St. Parascheva the New, St. Parascheva the Young, and St. Parascheva of the Balkans. In America, she is the patron of ARFORA and of the church in St. Laurent, QC.

St. Parascheva was born at the beginning of the 11th century A.D. into a wealthy, noble, and pious Christian family in the town of Epivat (now in Turkey) on the shores of the Marmara Sea. At the age of ten, while attending the Liturgy, she heard the words, "Whosoever will come after Me, let him deny himself and take up his cross, and follow me" (Marcu 8, 34). The words of the Lord had a profound effect on the young girl, and they became the subject of her meditations. The saint began to cloth the poor in her expensive clothes. (Continued on page 4)



CUVIOASA SFANTA PARASCHEVA DE LA IASI

Iasi, capitala Moldovei este așezat în Nord-Estul României. În Catedrala metropolei, într-o casetă de argint, străjuiesc moaștele Sfintei Parascheva. Ea este socotită sfânta patroană și ocrotitoare a Moldovei și în fiecare an, în 14 octombrie, ziua Sfintei, sute de mii de credincioși din țară și de pretutindeni vin la Iași ca să roage pe sfânta să mijlocească pentru ei. Sfintele sale moaște au fost aduse în Iași de Voievodul Vasile Lupu. În Europa de Răsărit sunt trei sfinte cunoscute sub numele de Parascheva. Prima a fost născută la Roma, în veacul al 2-lea. A doua, a fost născută în Iconia și a adormit în Domnul în veacul al 3-lea. A treia, ale cărei moaște se odihnesc în catedrala din Iași, a trăit după anul 1,000 A.D. și este cea mai cunoscută și cel mai mult cinstită de către Creștinii Ortodocși. Este cunoscută sub mai multe nume, printre care : Sf. Paracheva de la Tirnovo, Sfânta Paraschiva Sârbă, Sf. Paracheva de la Belgrad, Sfânta Parascheva cea tânără și Sfânta Paracheva a Balcanilor. În America de Nord, ea este patroana asociației femeilor, ARFORA și patroană a bisericii din St. Laurent, QC.

Sf. Paracheva a fost născută la începutul secolului al 11-lea dintr-o familie cu stare, nobilă și credincioasă din satul Epivat, de pe malul Mării Marmara. La vârsta de 10 ani, în timp ce participa la Sfânta Liturghie a auzit cuvintele: "De va vrea cînvea să vină după Mine, să se lepede de sine, să-și ia crucea sa și să-mi urmeze Mie" (Marcu 8,34). Cuvintele Domnului au avut un profund impact asupra tinerei fecioare, începând să lucreze în inima ei. A început să îmbrace pe săraci cu hainele ei scumpe. (Vezi pagina 4)

Later, she earned her recognition as a patron saint of such trades as spinning, sewing, weaving, and knitting – but her parents objected, finding the girl's charity more than they could understand or support, and trying to get her to stop. Following her calling, Parascheva abandoned wealth and privileges, left her parents, and ran away to Constantinople. There, near the relics of many saints, she spent her time in prayer, meditating on the words of Christ. To elude her parents, who were traveling from city to city trying to find her, she moved to Chalcedon, and then in Heraclea Pontica. She spent the next five years there, living an austere life of prayer and devotion. During her prayers she received visions of the Holy Virgin Mary. In one of the visions, she was instructed to go to Jerusalem. After spending some time in the city, she joined a convent in the Jordanian desert. A few years later, she returned to Constantinople and then, at the age of twenty five, moved to the village of Katikratia where, at the "Church of the Holy Apostles", she lived the remaining two years of her life. She returned to Epivata, where she died as a stranger. Later on her relics were moved to Tirnovo (today's Bulgaria), then to Belgrade (today's Serbia), and finally to Constantinople. In 1641, they were given as a gift to the Prince of Moldavia, Vasile Lupu, in recognition of his enormous financial support (500 bags of gold) given by him to the Ecumenical Patriarchate of Constantinople. Her intact relics have remained in Iasi ever since. She is venerated as the Protector of Iasi and all of Moldova. Each year, hundreds of thousands of Orthodox faithful and hierarchs from many countries gather in Iasi to celebrate her feast day and venerate her holy relics, which continue to work many miracles and healings among the faithful. 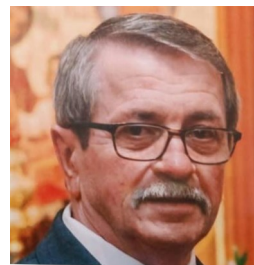
CUVIOASA SFÎNTA PARASCHEVA DE LA IAȘI

Mai târziu ea a devenit patroana torcătorilor, țesătorilor și al celor ce croșetează, însă părinții săi s-au opus faptelor ei de caritate, neînțelegând-o și punându-i piedici. Urmându-și chemare, Parascheva a renunțat la bogăție și privilegiile, și-a parasit familia și a plecat la Constantinopol. Acolo, lângă moaștele multor sfinți, și-a petrecut viața în rugăciune, cugetând la cuvintele lui Hristos. Ferindu-se de părinții care o căutau pretutindeni, sfânta s-a mutat la Calcedon, iar apoi la Heraclea Pontică. Și-a petrecut următorii cinci ani într-o austral viață de rugăciune și devoțiune. În timp ce se ruga a primit viziuni de la Preacurata Fecioara Maria. Într-una dintre viziuni, aceasta a instruit-o să meargă la Ierusalim. Ascultând, și-a petrecut viața în sfânta cetate, până când s-a alipit de o mănăstire de femei din pustia Iordaniei. Peste câțiva ani a revenit la Constantinopol, iar la vârsta de 25 de ani s-a mutat în Katicratia, unde și-a petrecut următorii doi ani la biserica *Sfinților Apostoli*. S-a întors apoi la Epivata, murind acolo ca o străină. Moaștele ei au fost mutate la Tirnovo (Bulgaria), apoi la Belgrad (Serbia) iar apoi la Constantinopol. În 1641 AD, moaștele ei au fost dăruite Domnitorului Vasile Lupu al Moldovei ca mulțumită pentru cei 500 pungi de aur plătite de el Sultanului pentru plata datoriei Patriarhiei Ecumenice. De atunci, moaștele ei întregi se află în Iași. Ea este cinstită ca ocrotitoare a Iașilor și a întregii Moldove. În fiecare an, sute de mii de pelerine și ierarhi din alte țări, de pretutindeni, se adună în Iași spre a cinsti praznicul și a venera sfintele sale moaște, care continuă să săvârșească numeroase minuni și să tămăduiască poporul bine-credincios. *Preacuvioasă Maică Parascheva, roagă-te lui Dumnezeu pentru noi!* (Reprodus)
